Day 1

- Arrival at Riga International Airport
- Transfer to hotel
- Overnight in Riga (5 star hotel)



Day 2

- Breakfast in hotel
- Walking excursion in Old Riga. See the medieval town with its quiet, narrow cobblestone streets, architectural masterpieces of past centuries and cosy cafes. In the very heart of the Old Town, you will visit the Dome Square. All Riga will be at your feet when elevator takes you up to the steeple of St.Peter's Church. Monument to Liberty, “Three Brothers” (oldest complex of dwelling houses), the Powder Tower and Jacob's Barracks are just some of other attractions for you to see.

- Overnight in Riga (5 star hotel)



Day 3

- Breakfast in hotel
- Rundale Palace - Masterpiece of Rococo and Baroque. Designed by the famous Italian architect Rastrelli, it was built as the summer residence for Ernst Johann von Biron, Duke of Courland. Also called the Palace of Versailles of the Baltics, Rundale Palace will astonish you from the first moment you lay your eyes on it.
- Overnight in Vilnius (5 star hotel)



Day 4

- Breakfast in hotel
- Walking excursion in Vilnius – the capital of Lithuania. Visit the Old Town of Vilnius where more than 1500 medieval buildings are located. You will see magnificent masterpieces built in neoclassic and gothic styles, for example, university of the 16th century in the Town Hall Square.
- Trakai Castle - an island of the Lake Galva houses a unique medieval castle built in 1321 by Grand Duke Gediminas. It is the only fortress built on waters in Europe.
- Overnight in Vilnius (5 star hotel)



Day 5

- Breakfast in hotel
- Rumsiskes Open Air Ethnographic Museum. This excellent museum is one of the largest in Europe and displays the heritage of Lithuanian rural life in a vast collection of authentic resurrected buildings where the Lithuanian people lived and worked. The total area of 175 ha contains 140 buildings from the 18th–19th century with the restored original interiors and surroundings.
- Overnight in Palanga (5 star hotel)



Day 6

- Breakfast in hotel
- Curonian Spit. Visit a unique natural formation - a 98 km long, thin, curved sand-dune spit that separates the Curonian Lagoon from the Baltic Sea. Traveling along the spit, you will visit Joudkrante – a park in forest with fantastic carved wooden figures depicting characters from Lithuanian folktales. Approaching the border of Russia, you will arrive in Nida – a beautiful sea resort town with ancient fishermen traditions. Parnidis dune lies there – it is the only place in Lithuania where one can see the sun rise and set in waters. See sun clock and Nida lighthouse.

Optional: visit Sea Museum.

- Overnight in Palanga (5 star hotel)



Day 7

- Breakfast in hotel
- Palanga - the biggest seaside resort town in Lithuania. Its white sand coast extends for 10 km and is backed by pine forests and dunes. Tyszkiewicz Palace was built in 19th century and surrounded by a park with ponds, fountains, and collections of rare plants. Nowadays the palace houses Amber Museum, and its exposition takes up 15 rooms. About 4 500 exhibit pieces are found here. Visitors are acquainted with the formation, processing, practical application and morphological variations of amber.
- Liepaja Naval Port is a touristic site characterized by Russian military elegance and Soviet militarism. At the end of the 19th century it was developed as a permanent urban setting for the base of the Navy of Czarist Russia. Apart from numerous military buildings, a magnificent Orthodox Cathedral (1900 – 1903), a prison and a system of defense forts have been preserved here. Also, you will see North Fortresses and Prison.
- Overnight in Kalnamuiza (manor)

Optional: Enjoy SPA treatment



Day 8

- Breakfast in hotel
- Kalvene Zoo. Enjoy excellent recreation in the countryside - in the world of interesting animals. The Zoo has the largest herd of kiangs kept in captivity in the world, as well as

brown bears, wolverines, wolves, lynxes, wild boars, Latvian blue cows and other animals.

- The Great Kemeru Swamp is one of the largest swamps in Latvia, and walking along a safe wooden trail, you will become a personal witness of pristine wildlife in this nature park. Enjoy the amazing view over the great swamp from the watching tower!
- Overnight in Riga (5 star hotel)

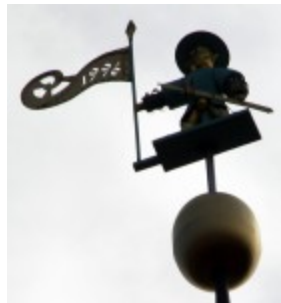


Day 9

- Breakfast in hotel
- Sigulda - Town of Medieval Castles and Breathtaking Landscapes. Visit Sigulda New Castle of the 19th century and see the ruins of Sigulda Old Castle. Air tram will take you across the Gauja River Valley to recently renewed medieval Castle of Turaida. You can climb its tower to enjoy the picturesque landscape of the valley from above. You will see the memorial place of Rose of Turaida. A legend of the 17th century tells of a beautiful girl who sacrificed her life to save her honor and love. At a blacksmith's forge you can even participate in the process of forging.

Optional: cross Gauja Valley in air tram

- Overnight in Parnu (5 star hotel)



Day 10

- Breakfast in hotel
- Walking excursion in Tallinn – the capital of Estonia. Visit one of most popular touristic sites – Town Hall (1402- 1404) and its Square. Another symbol of Tallinn – weathervane Vana Toomas (Old Thomas) can be seen guarding over the Old Town from the top of the Town Hall tower. Also the oldest pharmacy in Europe, numerous churches and workshops of glass-blowers are housed here.
- Overnight in Tallinn (5 star hotel)



Day 11

- Breakfast in hotel
- Muhu Island. Visit this unspoiled treasure of nature. It is characterized by its meadows, juniper forests and isolated farms. The dolomite cliff and caves on the northern shore, the 13th century St. Catharine's Church and the old Koguva fishing village are all worth visiting during your stay.

Optional: Enjoy a SPA treatment.

- Overnight in Muhu Island (5 star manor)



Day 12

- Breakfast in hotel
- Spend a leisurely day on the island and enjoy its nature.

Optional: Explore the island by car, go for a picnic, do canoeing, ride horses, go for a sunset boating trip.

Day 13

- Breakfast in Muhu Island
- Return to mainland

- Visit an authentic Latvian pottery workshop and both participate in making a clay pot with your own hands.
- Take a ride in a horse carriage to get to Baron Munchausen's estate. Baron Munchausen was a legend of his time – a German nobleman who was famous for his tall tales. According to the stories, as retold by others, the Baron's astounding feats included riding cannonballs and traveling to the Moon.

- Transfer to Riga International Airport
